We will have our specially trained Keepers on hand so the children can **ask all sorts of questions** and find out about the conservation work we do and what they can do at home.



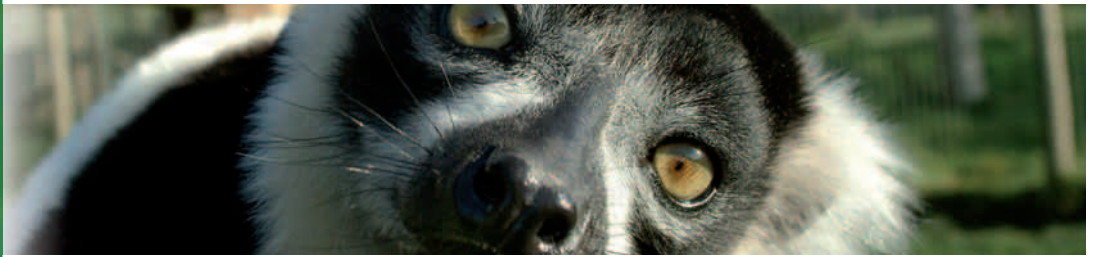
